Open House event at Dynagraph Lebanon

Dynagraph Lebanon s.a.l. inaugurates its new premises in Beirut

For the inauguration of its new headquarters in Beirut, Lebanon, Dynagraph held between the 12th and the 23rd of September 2005 an open doors event whereby over 100 customers from Kuwait, the Gulf region, Jordan, Syria and Lebanon gathered. The event was as well the occasion to announce the inauguration of the second MAN Roland Technology Transfer Centre to best serve customers in the near eastern region.

Demonstrations have been held on an elevated MAN Roland R505 LV, OB format offset press. At the special request of some of the visitors print tests were even conducted.

In addition two MBO folding machines, a K76 4 SKTL with a pile feeder and a K760 4 SKTL with a continuous feeder and a vertical stacker were on display as well as a guillotine 115 H-S Line from Schneider Senator fitted with touch screen and two stainless steel side tables. Finally an Aster 180 sewing machine from Mecchanotecnica, a 7 station collating machine from Theisen & Bonitz (B407) and the Universa 400 shrink wrapping machine from Kalfass were put on show.

The building works for the new Dynagraph headquarters started exactly one year and a half ago at a time where Lebanon was not subject to such a worrying period. The total built up area is 8,000 sqm the premise is located close to the Damascus road. Dynagraph is using around 3,500 sqm. Showroom and the warehouse occupy 2,500 sqm of space. The remaining 1,000 sqm are reserved for the administration, management, technical department, sales department, POP and SOP department, accounting department and IT departments.

Dynagraph traces its roots back to the 1970s. Dynagraph is at the cutting edge of transfer of printing technology.
