As Al-Yamamah Press Establishment seeks to maintain a leadership position in the newspaper publishing and printing sector the new FUJIFILM PRO-V low chemical technology offers just that and on Sunday 20th of March 2011 after months of deliberation the decision fell in favor of Dynagraph for two FFEI V-8 High Speed PRO-V Computer to Plate systems, an online NELA bending & punching, an XMF color management and a Newspaper Workflow management from INFRALOGIC with the intention to process daily over 5 different sizes of plates for its commercial, magazine and newspaper production.

The FFEI V-8 High Speed Ctp offers speeds of up to 82 plates per hour at 1200dpi while it meets the needs of both newspaper and commercial printers in terms of quality. The dual laser model removes fears of downtimes. The FFEI V-8 can still run on one laser. The lasers offer a long useful life of min. 8 years. Thanks to an internal drum technology, both plate and drum are static during the imaging process only a spinner mirror rotates at 60,000 rv/min.

Dynagraph has won a much sought after order and one of the determinant factor was an installed regional base of over 90 Computer to Plate Systems of the FFEI making and more recently a number of Low Chemical installations.

Al Yamamah's decision to go for the Fujifilm low chemical Ctp technology sets it apart from other customers as it is the First Low Chemical installation in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.
